- Maximum of three lines of lettering per inscription (each person is one inscription)
- Line separates non-related persons
- Months will be abbreviated
- All lettering must be completed by Greenwood Cemetery or its contractors. Tablets are the property of Greenwood Cemetery.
- Inscriptions must meet standards of good taste as determined by the superintendent.
- There is no choice of fonts.
- Customer may choose which tablet or which side of the tablet is used if room permits and there are no mitigating circumstances. Names will be added in columns and we cannot "skip a space" to save for future names.
- For inscriptions where the person is not yet deceased, a "final date cut" must be prepaid at the time of purchasing the inscription. The cemetery will inscribe this "final date cut" as soon as possible after being notified of that person's death.
- The customer may choose to not include dates at all.
